



CESifo Area Conference on Global Economy

Call for Papers

On 25 - 26 May 2012, CESifo will hold its annual meeting for the Global Economy research area, intended to allow presentation of current research undertaken by its members and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between area members.

Papers can be on any topic under the Global Economy field, covering trade, international finance, migration, global environmental issues, and others. Papers will be discussed in seminar format. Accepted papers will be published as CESifo Working Papers after revision.

The keynote lectures will be delivered by **Emanuel Ornelas (London School of Economics)** and **Beata Javorcik (University of Oxford)**.

Those CESifo Network members working on papers focused on the above are invited to submit their papers for presentation. The deadline for submissions is **30 March 2012**. For submission, please visit www.CESifo.org. Go to the Conferences page, click on the conference submenu and then on the name of the conference; follow then the "Submit Paper" link below the conference description. Only online submissions will be accepted. Should you have any (technical) difficulties with the online submission procedure, please contact saavedra@cesifo.de for assistance.

Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than 10 April 2012 whether their paper has been accepted for the conference.

CESifo will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy-class travel expenses for CESifo Research Fellows/Affiliates with accepted papers. A given paper is only allowed to be submitted to one of the CESifo area conferences. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences will be re-directed to the respective area coordinator.

Call for Nominations

With the purpose of encouraging talented young scholars, CESifo has instituted the Distinguished CESifo Affiliate prize, to be awarded to the best paper presented by a young author at the CESifo Area Conference on the Global Economy. Candidates will be accepted from close to completion of their PhD, to no more than three years after having completed it, and who are not older than 35. The same age limit applies to co-authors in the case of papers with multiple authors. The criteria for the award are scientific originality, policy relevance and quality of exposition. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series and the winner will receive €3000..

All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to nominate candidates for the award (please note that it is not mandatory for candidates to be members of the Research Network) To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Peter Egger, ETH Zürich (egger@kof.ethz.ch) and John Whalley, University of Western Ontario (jwhalley@uwo.ca) along with a letter explaining the motivation for the nomination.
