DISTINGUISHED CESIFO AFFILIATE AWARD

All CESifo Research Fellows are invited to submit nominations for the Distinguished CESifo Affiliate Award, given to the candidate presenting the best paper at the conference. Nominees for this award, aimed at encouraging talented young scholars, must be no more than five years after having completed their Ph.D. (the same limit applies to all co-authors in the case of a paper with multiple authors). It is not mandatory for candidates to be from the CESifo research network. The criteria for the award are scientific originality, policy relevance, and quality of exposition. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series, and the prize winner will receive a €2,000 prize. To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Maximilian Auffhammer along with a brief letter explaining the motivation for the nomination.
