The purpose of this conference is to facilitate discussion of ongoing research which studies policy relevant questions related to labor economics. Reflecting the breath of modern labor economics, the scope of relevant topics is broad, ranging from employment and compensation, immigration and migration, family and gender issues, inequality and poverty, and health and crime.

Since members of the relatively new labor economics area within CESifo will be built up over time, both existing CESifo network members and non-network members are encouraged to submit papers. Submissions using high quality/innovative data and convincing econometric methods are especially encouraged.

Accepted papers will be published as CESifo Working Papers.

Please note that the same paper is allowed to be submitted to only one of the CESifo Area Conferences. Papers which are more related to the topic of other Area Conferences may be re-directed to the respective Area Director.

DISTINGUISHED CESifo AFFILIATE AWARD

The **Distinguished CESifo Affiliate Award**, aimed at encouraging talented young scholars, will be awarded to the best paper presented by a young author at the conference. Accepted candidates will be invited to attend and present their paper. Candidates must be no more than five years after completing their PhD (same applies to any co-authors). The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series, and the prize winner will receive a €2,000 prize. All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to nominate candidates by submitting the nominee's paper to Gordon Dahl along with a CV and a brief note explaining the motivation for the nomination.

The **deadline for nominations** is **10 April 2024**.
